

## Library Update



Great Shelford Library will re-open for two sessions a week with effect from the week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> August. Sessions will be from 10am-2pm on Tuesdays and 2pm-6pm on Fridays.

However, the initial service will be limited to the return of items (which will then be quarantined), the collection of reservations and one pre-booked 45 minutes computer session per customer per day. Books can be reserved online or by phone and there will be a new 'Select and Collect' service, where you can suggest the type of books you'd prefer and staff will select available titles for you to collect from the library. Reservation charges are suspended until 31<sup>st</sup> August. There will be no browsing in the library yet, but we hope to be able to offer a wider service later in the year, subject to health and safety guidelines in place at the time.
